- Law No 326/1999 Coll, on Foreign Stays in the Czech Republic and information about changes in the law
- Since 11 June 2017 it is no longer necessary for Ukrainian citizens to have a visa; a biometric pass is sufficient. Such a stay cannot exceed 90 out of 180 days in Czech Republic or any other Schengen territory. This stay may only for tourism and, with exceptions (No 215/2017), the person is not allowed to work in the Czech Republic.

#### **Prices**

Remuneration for the provided treatments is determined according to the 'Methods of Accounting for Foreign Nationals in Nemocnice České Budějovice' (Metodiky účtování cizích státních příslušníků Nemocnice České Budějovice). Other information about the prices are available from the doctor providing your care or from +420 387 872 233.

#### **Method of payment**

If the foreign patient is not sufficiently insured, the hospital requires payment in cash. Bank transfers are only possible in special cases.

#### **Currency exchange**

There is not a currency exchange in the hospital area. Patients should therefore have the sufficient cash in Czech crowns. The nearest exchange is at the Česká spořitelna building, Lidická tř. 78, České Budějovice. See the [city map](#).

## **Schools**

### **INFORMATION ABOUT ENROLLING IN SCHOOL**

#### **COMMON PROVISIONS**

- Relevant legislation: Act No 561/2004 Coll, On pre-primary, basic, secondary, higher vocational, and other education (the Education Act).
  - Under the Education Act, EU citizens and their family members have access to education and school services under the same conditions as citizens of the Czech Republic.
  - Administrative fees are not fixed.
  - Queries can be directed to:

- It is possible to file an appeal against the decision of the school directors to the regional authority.

#### **PRE-SCHOOL EDUCATION**

##### **Organisation for pre-school education**

Non-EU citizens have access to pre-school education and school services under the same conditions as EU citizens if they have the right to stay in the territory of the Czech Republic for more than 90 days or if they are authorised to stay in the Czech Republic for research purposes, or as asylum seekers, beneficiaries of subsidiary protection, applicants for international protection, or persons enjoying temporary protection.

From the beginning of the school year following the day the child reaches the age of 5 to the beginning of the compulsory schooling of the child, pre-school education is compulsory.

Compulsory pre-school education also applies to citizens of other EU member states who reside in the Czech Republic for more than 90 days and to other foreigners who are entitled to stay permanently or temporarily in the Czech Republic for more than 90 days, or who are under international protection.

In the case of failure to declare a child for compulsory pre-school education, this is an offense for which a fine of up to CZK 5,000 can be imposed.

Pre-school education is provided for children as a rule from 3 to 6 years of age, but at the earliest from two years of age.

A child has the right of admission to a kindergarten established by a municipality or a union of municipalities if they have a place of residence in the relevant school district. A lawyer may choose another kindergarten established by the municipality or a union of municipalities or a nursery school by another provider.

#### Admittance of children into pre-school

- The child's legal representative submits to the school principal a written application for admission to pre-school education at kindergarten (application available at school or on the school's website):
  - on the date of registration published by a specific school (May 2–16), or
  - during the school year, if the school capacity allows.
- The lawyer will submit
  - the application for admission to pre-school education,
  - the child's birth certificate,
  - confirmation to the doctor that the child is properly vaccinated according to the vaccination schedule (not required for children with compulsory pre-school education);
  - a document proving the child's place of residence in the case of a non-EU alien:
    - a biometric card of the child indicating the address of the residence in the CR, or
    - a passport with a visa stamped by the Foreign Police with the address of the child's residence in the CR, or
    - proof of the residence permit, issued at the request of an alien and after payment of the fifteen-hundred-crown bill of work of the Department of Asylum and Migration Policy of the Ministry of the Interior,
- other documents as required by the nursery school director.
- The deadline for processing the application is 30 days.
- The decision granting the application for admission to education is announced by publishing the list of candidates under the assigned registration number in a publicly accessible place at the school.
- A registration number will be assigned to the child for entry.
- A non-acceptance decision is sent in written form

### **BASIC EDUCATION - COMPULSORY SCHOOL**

Admitting pupils to primary school

- Non-EU citizens have access to basic education as EU citizens.
- The legal representative of a minor applies for a written request to the school header during the whole year, or to appear with the child for the first year (in the case of a prospective pupil of the first year) at the time of enrollment in compulsory school attendance April 1–30).
- An application for admission to an elementary school is submitted to the headmaster of the elementary school located in the school district where the pupil has his permanent residence, unless a lawyer elects another elementary school.

- The lawyer will submit:
  - application for admission of a child to elementary school,
  - the child's birth certificate, and
  - other documents as required by the headmaster of the elementary school.
- The deadline for processing the application is 30 days.

1. The functioning of the elementary school for pupil education in English in České Budějovice (appeal to Brno):

In Brno, the International School of Brno, Čejkovická 4339/10, 628 00 Brno, which is a foreign school (schools that carry out education in the Czech Republic according to a foreign educational program according to Section 38 (1) (c) of the Education Act).

- They educate children of different nationalities.
- Language of instruction: English
- Founder: private
- Registered in the register: yes
- Tuition for 2018/2019:
  - a. Kindergarten: CZK 209,000 / year
  - b. 1st–6th year Primary School CZK 255,000 / year
  - c. 7th–9th year Primary School CZK 286,000 / year

In the South Bohemian Region, Townshend International School, Hradčany 1070, 373 41 Hluboká nad Vltavou, is set up under the same manner (ie foreign school).

2. Teaching in 1st–5th grade at the ZŠ České Budějovice, Matice školské, in English:

- From an interview with the director of the primary school, Mgr Rychlíková, shows that they do not implement and do not plan on teaching in english.
- According to the Education Act (Section 13 (1) (3)), the language of instruction is Czech, and the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports may allow the teaching of certain subjects in a foreign language. This means that the required education (1st–5th grade in English) cannot be implemented.

## **MIDDLE EDUCATION**

Admitting pupils to high school

- Candidates for admission to secondary education must have completed compulsory schooling or basic education before beginning compulsory school attendance.
- Required documents: The applicant submits to the school principal:
  - a written application for education,
  - a certificate of the last 2 years in which the applicant has completed or fulfills compulsory school attendance. If the applicant has completed compulsory schooling in the territory of another state, they must submit a certificate from a foreign school for the last two years, in the original (in an officially certified copy) and in an officially certified translation of the certificate into the Czech language (unless the papers are in the Slovak language) or a certificate of recognition of the foreign certificate issued by a foreign school, medical opinion on medical fitness for training, if required, and other documents demonstrating compliance with the admission criteria set by the school head.

- Admission procedure: In the fields of education with a matura examination there is always a single admission test of Czech language and literature and of mathematics. Persons with Czech or foreign citizenship who have obtained previous education at a school outside the territory of the Czech Republic are admitted to the admission procedure at their request pursuant to Section 20 (4) of the Education Act, the admission exam in the Czech language, or knowledge of the Czech language that is necessary for education, will be verified by interview.

- Minutes: After the successful entrance examinations and admission to secondary school, the applicant submits to the school head a registration card (does not refer to further education, short-term studies, and non-formal forms of education). An applicant who is a pupil of the elementary school will receive a registration card at this elementary school. In other cases, at the request of the applicant or their legal guardian, the registration card shall be issued by the regional authority responsible for the applicant's permanent residence, for foreigners according to the place of residence in the territory of the Czech Republic, or the headquarters of the school where the applicant is registered.

- Foreigners who are not citizens of the European Union become pupils of the respective secondary school unless the headmaster demonstrates the right to stay in the territory of the Czech Republic at the latest at the commencement of their education (Section 20 (3) of the Education Act).

- The admission procedure is governed by:
  - o Act No 561/2004 Coll, on pre-school, basic, secondary, higher professional, and other education (the Education Act),
  - o on Decree No 353/2016 Coll, on admission procedures for secondary education
